

**AUSTRALIAN INSTITUTE FOR THE CONSERVATION OF CULTURAL MATERIALS
(AICCM)**

ADFAS SCHOLAR GRANTS

Overview:

The Association of Australian Decorative and Fine Arts Societies (ADFAS) has been a strong supporter of the AICCM since 2010. Following the trial of a number of ways to distribute the granting monies provided by ADFAS the following proposal outlines how ADFAS support, through the Patricia Robertson Fund, will be provided in the coming years.

Proposal:

ADFAS is a community of members interested in developing an appreciation of art history and fostering an understanding of contemporary cultural works. Philanthropy is central to the ADFAS ethos. Currently, ADFAS has a commitment to advance conservation practice and through the awards ADFAS aims to both support the development of conservation professionals and raise the profile of ADFAS amongst those interested in the conservation of cultural material.

It is proposed that from 2020-2022 ADFAS will partner with the AICCM to offer the following awards:

UoM / UCan Convenors are to submit the proposed awardee to the Membership Services Officer for verification by ADFAS. | Awardee recipient is determined by a Committee to include: Membership Services Officer, AICCM President and ADFAS Selection Committee. Selection criteria of the award will be: Benefit to recipient's career Benefit to the AICCM and profession. |

In the case that a project may not be completed by this stage, an interim report may be accepted. 2. Submit an article of approximately 400 words by 1st July to inform both the ADFAS membership (6500+) and the AICCM e- news readers (5000+) of the benefits of receiving the scholarship 3. If feasible present a lecture at a local society of ADFAS or AICCM local meeting about how the scholarship was used. <p>Articles and/or lectures are to be organised by the awardee in conjunction with AICCM and/or ADFAS and must be presented no later than 9 months after the announcement of the awards.</p> |


