
**When** Thursday 13 February  
**Lecturer** Dennis Panchaud  
**Topic** Australian Women at War (1938-1946)

Dennis originally trained as an architect. Later he trained to teach Art & Design at primary, junior and senior level. He taught in schools in inner city London and Bristol and also in independent fee-paying schools. Privately he has produced works in a variety of media, including watercolours, prints, graphic design and illustration. Since coming to Australia Dennis has been a regular lecturer in Art History & Appreciation for U3A for the past 8 years and is a guest lecturer at the Art Gallery of the University of the Sunshine Coast. Dennis lives at Buderim.

“Australian Women at War” focusses on a relatively small group of Australian women artists who contributed to the documentary art of the Second World War, both at home and abroad, only three of whom were actually appointed as official war artists.

David Iliffe’s interview with Dennis will be broadcast on the ABC Local Radio’s Breakfast Programme on the morning of the lecture at around 7am.
