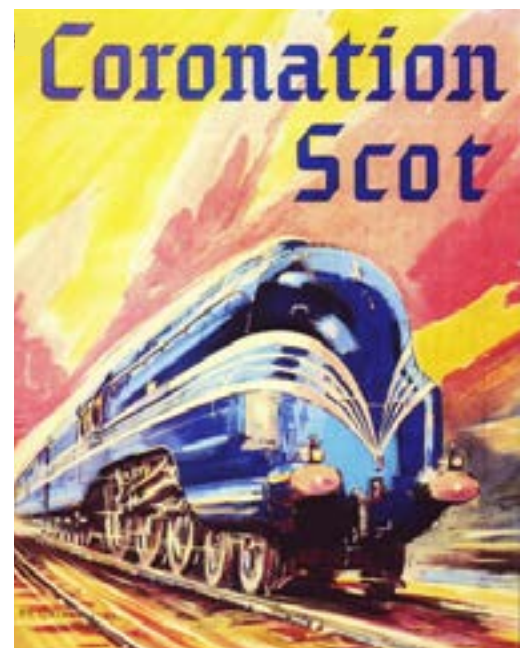
DEAR MEMBERS
